Roof Works: The first phase of our roof works begins on 28 June. The Cloth Fair entrance to the churchyard will be closed for 12 weeks. Scaffolding in the churchyard will enable the contractors to access the roof. The quire and sanctuary will be re-leaded. Meanwhile we begin exploratory works on the north transept roof and fundraising for the next phase of re-roofing.

Organ Works: The present pipe organ will be taken out of use this month. Until the new organ is installed, probably in mid-to-late 2011, there will be a state-of-the-art electronic organ, previously used at Llandaff Cathedral during the rebuilding of their organ.

The Cloister Café Bar is open after 9.00 Holy Communion on Sundays, before and after the Solemn Eucharist, and before Evensong. It is also open on weekdays 10.00 to 4.30 (closed Saturdays).

Said **Holy Communion** is celebrated in the Lady Chapel on Sundays at 9.00 a.m. There are also weekday celebrations on Tuesday at 12.30 p.m. and Thursday at 8.30 a.m.

The Sunday **Solemn Eucharist**, beginning at 11.00 a.m., is sung by the full Choir under the direction of David Trendell. In addition to hymns, the introit, alleluia and communion sentence are sung (in Latin). There is a setting of the Kyrie, Gloria, Sanctus, Benedictus and Agnus Dei and an offertory motet. There is usually a sermon.

Choral Evensong at 6.30 p.m. completes the range of Sunday services. It comes from the Book of Common Prayer (1662) with readings from the Authorised Version (1611). The Choir sings the psalm or psalms, the Magnificat and Nunc dimittis, an anthem, and the final Marian anthem. There is usually a sermon. Once a month there is Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament at the conclusion of Evensong.
